- 1. Authors should use online submission/review for their manuscripts to *Taiwan Economic Review* (hereafter *TER*).

- 3. Manuscripts accepted for publication in *TER* should be prepared in accordance with "Writing Style for *TER*".
- 4. TER adopts a double-blind review process.
- 5. The copyright of accepted manuscripts will be transferred to TER.
- 6. *TER* charges no submission fee and pays no remuneration to authors. Authors of accepted articles will receive two free copies of *TER* annual bound issue in which their article appears.
- 7. If the author has not been notified as to the status of the manuscript after three months, inquiries can be addressed to *TER* at econman@ntu.edu.tw.
- 8. A maximum of two rounds of major revision per manuscript is typically provided.

It was first issued in 1970 under the title Economic Essays, and published annually prior to 1987 and bi-annually in 1987. Since then it has been changed to a quarterly (March, June, September, December) under the current title Taiwan Economic Review (The Chinese title remains unchanged).
